I Caroline Harris of the aforesaid County and State, being of sound mind, but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence, do make and declare this to be my last will and Testament. First I appoint as my executors J.H. Hurt and W.H. Bray of the County and State above-named and have delivered all my effects to them and they shall dispose of my property both personal and real to the best advantage for all the heirs and apply the proceeds as follows after all expense is paid. Then I give and bequeath one thousand dollars \$1000.00 to Annie Harris and Ida Harris Weston both at the State Hospital at Morganton N.C. to be divided equal between them and so that the remaining part of my estate shall be divided in three parts, and I will that Verlie Estee Brown my Grand daughter shall have  $\frac{1}{3}$  two thirds of one third's above named; and that the remaining part of my estate shall then be divided in three equal parts and that John J. Harris shall have one third's of same.

William Harris one third's of same and Mary Jane Baithard one third's to her only use and behoof as long as she lives and then to her bodily heirs.

Caroline Harris signed, sealed and delivered by the said Caroline Harris to be her last will and testament, in the presence of us who at her request and in her presence do subscribe our names as witnesses thereto.

1<sup>st</sup> My executor herein after named shall give my body a decent burial suitable to the wishes of my friends and relatives, and pay all funeral expenses, together with all my just debts out of the first moneys which may come into his hands belonging to my estate.

2<sup>nd</sup> I give and devise to my beloved daughter Della or her heirs Cynthia Louise Hobson her heirs being named as follows, John H Hobson, Bertha Hobson, Margarit Hobson, & Dallas Hobson in fee simple a tract of land in Fall Creek Township - Yadkin County adjoining the lands of Everett R E Matthewson Hobson father and in the division of my land this being Lot No. 1 known as the Nealy Canale tract of land containing 1/4 acre or less.
