In the name of God Amen.
I, Christian Reinhardt of the County of Gaston
and State of North Carolina being of sound
mind and memory do therefore make,
ordain and declare this to be my last will
and testament, that is to say first after
all my lawful debts are paid and
discharged the residue of my personal
estate I give and bequeath and dispose
of as follows, to wit: After a decent
burial the residue of my estate to be
sold and equally divided between the
heirs of my son Christian and Frederick
Reinhardt To my son John I bequeath
the sum of one dollar, he having had
his share of my estate heretofore; to
my grand daughter Margaret son Christian
Frederick Shore, I give and bequeath
my Bureau with its contents, also
one bed & bed and under bed
It is my will and request that Robert
Gentry and his wife Sarah keep the
said Bureau and its contents and
bedstead & under bed for the said
Christian Frederick Shore until
he is twenty one years of age and
then to deliver the said property to
him - likewise I make, constitute
and appoint J. H. Holcomb to be
executor of this my last will and
testament hereby revoking all
former will by me made.
