Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Sallie One Bed & furniture One Chair Wheel & Caras One Flax Wheel One Churn Four head of Hogs One Sheep one pig Four Chairs & half the Kitchen furniture & One Hoe

Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Anne of One Bed & furniture and one Chair Wheel & Caras One Flax Wheel One Churn Four Chairs Four head of Hogs one Sheep one pig & half the Kitchen furniture & One Hoe

Item I give & bequeath to my above named Daughters one Horse Cartboard. Item I give & bequeath to my son William One Horse brack all the Balance of my estate & Hogs one Rifle gun. my wife & desire is that my son William have all the Balance of my Estate either real or personal to him & his heirs & executors & Administrators forever. And lastly I do hereby constitute appoint my son William my lawful executor to all intents & purposes to execute this my last will & Testament according to the true intent & meaning of the same & every part & clause thereof hereby revoking & declaring utterly void all other other Wills & Testaments by me heretofore made in which Wherof I the said Sley Denny do hereunto set my hand & seal this the sixteenth day of Novr A D 1853.

I David Hobson of Surry ~~State of North Carolina~~ the County of Surry & State of North Carolina being of sound mind & memory but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make & declare this my last Will & Testament in manner & form following that that is to say first that my executor (herein after named) shall shall provide for my body a decent burial suitable to the wishes of my relations & friends & pay all funeral expenses together with just debts. Whosoever & to Whomsoever owing out of the money that may first come into their hands as a part or parcel of my estate. I then give & devise at my said daughter Ann North wife of Jonathan North that tract of Land the now lie on containing one hundred & fifteen acres more or less & I also will my daughter John North one hundred & fifteen acres of land that I hold against her husband Jonathan North & the Interest in the Land 2^d Item it is it is my will also that that my five Grandchildren & heirs of my second daughter Rachel named follows viz. Imah Dinah Susanah David & Jonathan Vitalize my will that they have twenty dollars each each of them with its interest from the present date when they arrive to the age of twenty one years of age & after they arrive to that age the Interest to stop & stop further my will that each of them have twenty dollars out of my household estate. 3^d Item I give & bequeath unto my eldest son David Hobson two hundred dollars in Cash & one horse mare Colt. to him & his heirs forever. 3^d Item I give unto my third daughter Dinah Huff two hundred dollars in Cash to her & her heirs forever. 4th Item I give unto my son John Hobson all of my home tract of land that I now live on & all adjoining land to it containing seven hundred & 15 acres of Land I also will bind my Black Smith Tools one Flax Wheel six putter plates two putter dishes & two putter Basins & the ballance of my putter to be equally divided between my other two sons John to have his ~~part~~ part out of the putter that they have commonly used in the Kitchen & one iron mare named Seal & one Iron Pot named the wash Pot & one pot, candle dinner pot & one basin skillet & one flat bottomed skillet & one feather Bed & Bedstead & covering & all of my plow & Hoes & adst & maters & half of my flock of Sheep & all of my Hogs & also my two Wheat Chaffs & flax seed sowing & my ground stone & all my tubs & my Loom & all that belongs to it.

4. In Black Walnut Chest Collected his m^o. all to
belong to him & his heirs forever 5th Item I gave &
by death unto my son George Hobson one hundred
dollars in hand also one black Walnut Chest
my Bed Bed Steals & furniture also one hundred
feet of black Walnut plank to him & his heirs forever

has not been devised in this my last will that is
in Collection & Equally divided amongst all of my
Children namely Ann David Denah John &
George Hobson names of my Grand Children

sons David John & George Hobson my lawful Executors to
all intents & purposes to Exec to this my last Will testament
according to the true intent & meaning of the same & every
part & every clause thereof hereby revoking & declaring
utterly voids all other Wills & Testaments heretofore made

estate that is not disposed of otherwise before my son John
gets any of it then the balance if any to be equally divided
among all of my children & it is further my will that the
State that I have against my son George Hobson of his wife
Sally is to be counted out of the Hundred dollars that
I have willed him

Gun one Shot Gun one set of Cooper Tools one set
of Smiths Tools all my augers and Chisels and Boring
Bits and all such tools as he may see fit and
one saddle and gun Hocks Barbed timber one
leat saw and plains and farming Tools also to
sell any debts due me in a word all such
property as is not of use to my beloved wife and
apply the money to the use of paying my debts and
paying expence if any should remain to apply it to
the use of my beloved wife Sally Wiskow as she may
need it and at her death to sell all my property and
divide equal among all my children in sort of
whereof I have heretofore set my hand and affixed my
seal this the 21 day of January A.D. 1854 Signed
