her life term or widowhood

executor to execute this Will.

shares of personal property as I have given him to
him as children of which bequeathed & executed and in
addition bequeathed to him as much money to be paid
him as he may after death.

I Will and bequeath to my daughter Mary A. Adams
wife of John Adams all my right and title to the land
situated in the town of which I have bequeathed & executed
to be sold and the said John Adams to give and
convey the same to him and his heirs and assigns
to her all the personal property I may have given her
from time to time. She being now in possession of
all of it and the addition of twenty (\$20) per
dollar to be paid her by my executor as he may see fit.

I Will and bequeath to my daughter Charles wife
of John Adams for all the property of personal
nature I have bequeathed to her of which she is now
in possession and on order to make her equal with my
other married children. I hereby Will and bequeath
her the sum of one hundred & twenty five dollars in
current money and the additional sum of (\$20)
per dollar in gold & silver to be paid her part of
some of her property belonging to her mother. I
thereby bequeath five per cent of my said daughter
Charles wife of John Adams. By my executor as he may see fit
in money and goods as he may see fit.
