hands belonging to my estate.

Second: I give and devise to Mrs Jennie Barty
the tract of land on which I now reside
containing 54 acres more or less this being
all of the land I own, for her natural life
time, then at her death the land to go
to J. W. Barty.

Third: It is my will and desire that
all my Personal Property be sold by
my Executrix and the money arising from
such sale be used to pay my funeral
expenses and such debts as I might owe.

Fourth: I hereby constitute and appoint
my niece Mrs Jennie Barty my lawful
executrix to all intents and purposes
to execute this my last will and
Testament according to the true intent
and meaning of the same and every part

and clause thereof. In witness whereof I the said
