mind and memory do hereby make publickly and
declare this to be my last will and testament
after paying all of my just debts, doctor bills
and burial expenses.

Item 1. I will all my personal property, all money
notes or debts owing to me at the time of my death
to my wife Nancy Williams her life time and at
her death to be equally divided between my 5
children J W Williams and P S Williams
and Mary Lundiff Amanda Turner and Calla
Sauers. Item 2. I will all of my Real estate
to my wife Nancy Williams her life time and
all rents and profits at her death.

Item 3. I will all of my land to my two boys
J W Williams & P S Williams. I will the South west
end of my land to P S Williams Beginning at a red
or permanent tree near Luther Estale at the old red
tree Eastward with old road by the head of the
old fence post, Then East to join Rees corner
before it be forty acres more or less in said
track. I will all of my land on the North East
of the line of P S Williams to my son J W Williams
his lifetime and at his death to his legal heirs
suppose to be about forty acres more or less this
being the land that the said James Williams
now live on. Item 4. I will that J W Williams
and P S Williams pay to my three daughters and their
heirs in case I fail to my Granddaughter Mollie
Lundiff and her heirs the sum of Fifty Dollars to be
paid in 2 years after my death. I will to
Amanda Turner and her heirs the sum of Fifty
Dollars to be paid in Two years after my death
I will to my daughter Calla Sauers and her
heirs the sum of Fifty dollars to be paid in

Two years after my death. Item 5. I will that P W Williams
and B Williams each pay one half of the above amount
to be equally divided in each of them.

Item 6. I hereby constitute and appoint my son P S
Williams as my executor to this my last will and
testament.
