I Julia Ann Catharine Paridexter of the aforesaid County and State, being of sound mind, but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence, do make and declare this my last will and testament:
First: My Executor, herein after named, shall give my body a decent burial, suitable to the wishes of my friends and relatives.
Second: I give and devise to W. H. Stimpson my house and lot on corner of 5th and Spruce Street, in the City of Winston-Savannah, North Carolina.
Third: I give and bequeath to the heirs at law of my brother John Levi Speas, to the heirs at law of Elizabeth Rebecca Jayner my sister, to the heirs at law of my brother William Henry Speas, to the heirs at law of my sister Elizabeth Mandy Spillman, to the heirs at law of my sister Anna Malindy Davis to the heirs at law of my brother Isaac Nathaniel Speas, to the heirs at law of my brother Samuel Benjamin Speas, to the heirs at law of Katharine Paulina Apperson my sister and to my sister Mary Permelia Bynum (in case that my sister Mary Permelia Bynum should die before my death then her interest to go to her heirs at law) the sum of One Thousand dollars \$1000⁰⁰ in money to be divided equally among them that is to say 1/4 of \$1000⁰⁰ to be divided among the heirs at law of John Levi Speas, 1/4 of \$1000⁰⁰ among the heirs at law of Elizabeth Rebecca Jayner 1/4 of \$1000⁰⁰ among the heirs at law of William Henry Speas, 1/4 of \$1000⁰⁰ among the heirs at law of Elizabeth Mandy Spillman 1/4 of \$1000⁰⁰ among the heirs at law of

Anna Malindy Davis, 1/4 of \$1000⁰⁰ among the heirs at law of Isaac Nathaniel Speas, 1/4 of \$1000⁰⁰ among the heirs at law of Samuel Benjamin Speas, 1/4 of \$1000⁰⁰ among the heirs at law of Katharine Paulina Apperson and 1/4 of \$1000⁰⁰ to Mary Permelia Bynum (in case of her death before my death, then 1/4 to be heirs at law) It is my will and desire that they shall have said \$1000⁰⁰ and no more of my property.
Fourth: I give and bequeath to W. H. Stimpson after taking out the \$1000⁰⁰ one thousand dollars bequeathed in Paragraph Third of this my last will and testament, all my personal property of every kind and description, including all moneys, bank deposits the belonging to me with. I hereby constitute and appoint W. H. Stimpson my lawful executor, to all intents and purposes, to execute this my last will and testament, according to the true intent and meaning of the same, and every part and clause thereof, hereby revoking and declaring utterly void all other wills and testaments by me heretofore made.
