I, L. B. Roberson, of the aforesaid County and state, being of sound mind but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence to make and declare this my last Will and Testament:

1st: My executor, hereinafter named, shall give my body a decent burial, suitable to the wishes of my friends and relatives and pay all funeral expenses, together with all of my just debts, out of the first money coming into his hands belonging to my estate.

Second: I give and devise to my beloved wife M. J. Carson all of my property, both real and personal, except as hereinafter provided during her natural life, or so long as she shall remain my widow and upon her death or marriage I give and devise all of the said property to my several children as herein after specified.

Third: I will and devise to my beloved son John D. Roberson, to take effect upon the death or marriage of my beloved wife, the following real estate to-wit: One half of the Canada Williams lands being the south side of said lands and containing 84 acres more or less and being that part of said land where I now live.

Fourth: I will and devise to my beloved son Herman Butler Roberson, to take effect upon the death or marriage of my beloved wife, the following real estate to-wit: The North side of the Canada Williams tract, being one half of said tract and containing 84 acres more or

less and upon which is located my former dwelling house.

Fifth:

I give and devise to my beloved daughters, Nouelle Morteller, Julie Ann Wilkinson, Dolly Salmon, Dixie Reece and Millie Roberson the following real estate to -rent: 49 acres more or less, adjoining the lands of Sam Brown, Went Brown, Lee Holcomb and others and known as a part of the old Stare lands; also one other tract adjoining the lands of Lee Holcomb, Jane Holcomb, the Jacob Wagner lands and others, containing 15 acres more or less. The provisions of this paragraph shall not take effect until the death or marriage of my beloved wife and upon her death or marriage the said two tracts are to go to my said daughters named in this paragraph, to be divided between them equally, share and share alike.

Sixth:

I will and devise to my beloved daughters Nouelle Morteller, Julie Ann Wilkinson, Dolly Salmon, Dixie Reece and Millie Roberson all of my life insurance except so much thereof as may be necessary to be used by my executor to pay my funeral expenses and in addition thereto a sufficient amount to pay for such tombstones or monument as the said executor may see proper to erect at my grave.

Seventh:

Upon the death or marriage of my beloved wife I will and devise to my beloved son, John D. Roberson to take effect upon the death or marriage of my beloved wife,

two mules, two two-horse wagons and harness, one Deering Binder, two two-horse plows, one Disk plow, three cultivators, two Dixie plows a lot of hoes and mattocks, one set blacksmith's tools, one set carpenter's tools, two cross cut saws, one Ford automobile, one, one ten Ford truck.

Eighth: I hereby constitute and appoint my trusted friend N.D. Mackie my lawful Executor to all intents and purposes to execute this my last Will and Testament according to the true intent and meaning thereof and hereby revoke and declare void any and all wills or testaments heretofore made by me.
