and declare this my last will and testament.  
(First) My executors hereinafter named shall give  
my body a decent burial suitable to the wishes  
of my relatives and pay all my funeral expenses  
together with all my just debts out of the first  
monies which may come into their hands belong-  
ing to my estate.

(Second) I give and devise to my sister Nancy  
Jane Shields my entire interest in a certain house  
and lot in the Town of East Bend, Yadkin Co. NC.  
which lot is bounded on the South by the lands  
of John A. Hill, on the west by Al Prentiss  
on the North by Cherry Street, on the East by  
Mary Drulow, the same being where Nancy Jane  
Shields now lives. My interest in the said house  
and lot is one half.

(Third) It is my will and desire that all the  
remainder of my property of every kind and  
description be equally divided between my sister  
Nancy Jane Shields and my brother J.S. Shields  
I hereby constitute and appoint my brother  
J.S. Shields and my sister Nancy Jane Shields  
my lawful executors to all intents and
