This Bible was printed in 1846 and on title page has "Richmond, Va." written in...The interesting part of the Dible is that a page of COOK and a page of PROSSER entries have been deposited in this Bible...The family says that these pages came from an old Bible that had since disintegrated. These pages were save and placed in the Cardwoll Bible some time after 1046.

The family know that Virginia, North and South Carolina have been the homes of these families but they have no idea as to what portion of these states these people resided but they think in the vicinity of Richmond, Va. and Charlotte, N.C. and Columbia, S.C.

The family tradition is that ELIZABETH wife of WILLIAM PROSSER was not OTEY.
