MARY PROSSER was born the 25th day of September 1762

ELIZABETH PROSSER was born the 14th day of September 1764

ANN PROSSER was born the 5th day of September 1766

REBECCA PROSSER was born the 3rd day of November 1768

JOHN PROSSER was born the 17th day of February 1771

GEORGE PROSSER was born the 2nd day of April 1773

SUSAN PROSSER was born the 17th day of July 1781

ANN, the daughter of WILLIAM & ELIZABETH PROSSER, was married the 27th day of April 1786 to JOHN DARRONS

ANN, the wife of JOHN DARRONS, departed this life the 6th day of March 1805

JOHN DARRONS departed this life the 6th day of January 1814

MARY, the daughter of JOHN & ANN DARRONS, departed this life the 4th day of Oct. 1707

ELIZABETH OTEY DARRONS was born the 10th day of July 1787 and was married the 16th day of November 1806 to JOHN LIGON COOK

FRANCIS RICHARD STRODIE departed this life the 28th day of February 1813

This Bible was printed in 1846 and on title page has "Richmond, Va." written in...The interesting part of the Bible is that a page of COOK and a page of PROSSER entries have been deposited in this Bible...The family says that these pages came from an old Bible that had since disintegrated. These pages were save and placed in the Cardwell Bible some time after 1846.

The family know that Virginia, North and South Carolina have been the homes of these families but they have no idea as to what portion of these states these people resided but they think in the vicinity of Richmond, Va. and Charlotte, N.C. and Columbia, S.C.

The family tradition is that ELIZABETH wife of WILLIAM PROSSER was nee OTEY.
