David A. and John L.M. were listed as gold miners in the 1852 California census. Did they remain in CA? Any information on these Wades would be appreciated!

EDITOR'S NOTE: Auraria was Georgia's "Gold Rush" town, and Lumpkin Co. was the site of the discovery of gold. The Federal Mint at Dahlonega, GA minted gold coins for the government until it was seized by the Confederates at the beginning of the Civil War. It seems likely that the young Wade men moved over to Georgia during our gold rush, then followed the "mother lode" to CA.
