A son of Dr. Samuel Perryman and Sarah Watson his wife was  
General William Watson Perryman, married Sue Elizabeth Partlow  
on Feb. 15th, 1851. They settled at New Market, South Carolina.  
After the stormy days of 1860-1865 in which he took an active  
part - (Forming the 1st Company, being 1st Captain of Sece-  
sion Guards formed at Greenwood, S. C. Co. F. 2nd Regiment,  
Kershaw's Brigade. He led them to the battlefields of Virginia  
where they fought gallantly). When the Civil War was over he  
moved with his family to Liberty, Liberty Co. Texas. His  
sterling qualities were soon recognized by his adopted State  
and he was made a judge which office he held until death  
claimed him in 1890.

His eldest son James Samuel Perryman was suddenly killed by  
being thrown from a wagon of cotton on his father's plantation  
Oct. 20th, 1869. He was born at New Market, S. C. Oct. 8, 1852.  
2nd child Wm. Richard Perryman died in infancy.

3rd child Mary Elizabeth Perryman born at New Market, S. C.  
6th of Feb. 1856. Married J. R. Perryman at St. Charles Hotel,  
New Orleans, La. April 21st, 1885; died at Liberty, Texas Oct.
