The name Cantrell can be traced to the family of Chantrell, or Cantrelle, in France. The first mention of the name outside France is William Chantrell, who retained the French spelling of the name in England, andin the time of King John. From the 12 th to the 15th centuries the name appears in English records from time to time, and after that time it appears many times in England and Ireland, spelled Chantrell. Cantrill. or Cantrell. The name first appears in America in 1608, at Jamestown, Virginia, and since that time there have been eight - possibly more - distinct families of Cantrill-Cantrell who have cometo this country from England, Ireland, and France.
