

-RECORD OF THE HENRY FAMILY-  
Wm. and Isabella Henry

The family are Irish from Tirono, Ireland- moved to York County, South Carolina before the revolutionary war. There were several grown sons engaged in the battle of Kings Mountain- none were killed; but when they returned home bullet holes were made in their clothing and their hair which was long was scorched off by British shot and powder. One of these, Frank Henry, was still alive in August 20th., 1859 being 100 years old, still living at the old homestead at Henry's knob near Kings Mountain. James S. Chambers had a conversation with him at the above mentioned ~~DATE~~ date. The family first settled in Maryland or Pennsylvania- moved to South Carolina. (Ga)
