## -RECORD OF THE HENRY FAMILY-

The family are Irish from Tirone, Ireland-moved to York County, South Carolina before the revolutionary war. There were several grown sens engaged in the battle of Kings Mountain- none were killed; but when they returned home bullet heles were made in their elething and their hair which was long was secreted off by British shot and powder. One of these, Frank Henry, was still alive in August 20th., 1859 being 100 years old, still living at the old homestend at Henry's knob near Kings Mountain. James S. Chambers had a conversation with him at the above mentioned REXEK date. The family first settled in Maryland or Pennsylvania- moved to South Carolina. GAr
