FIRST GENERATION

1. Martha Elizabeth¹ Sturgis, daughter of John Sturgis Sr. and Anna Wright, was born 24 May 1792 in York County, South Carolina.¹ She married first Wyatt Reeves, son of Wiley Reeves and Rebecca Thompson, circa 1809. Wyatt was born about 1784, probably in South Carolina, and died about 1826 in Fayette County, Georgia. Elizabeth married second to Jesse Weathers, son of Isham Weathers and Mary Weathers, 24 January 1832 in Fayette County, Georgia. Jesse was born in North Carolina during year 1805.

Although a marriage record for EWWWENDERFUNGATED Reeves has not been found, their marriage probably took place in York County, South Carolina around 1808 or 1809. After their marriage we first find the young couple listed in the 1810 York County, South Carolina census. Wyatt was then 26 to 45 years of age and his wife [Elizabeth] 16 to 26 years of age with no children. The Bible record tells us that Elizabeth was then 18 years of age so Wyatt must have been around 26 or 27 years of age.

The Wyatt Reeves Family Moves to Georgia

We next find Wyatt Reeves listed in the 1820 Census taken for Jasper County, Georgia.⁴ Wyatt and his wife were then both age 26 to 45. They had enlarged their family to include four young children, two boys and two girls, all under 10 years of age. There was also an unknown male 16 to 26 years of age living with the family, probably a relative. The Jasper County land records revealed that Wyatt Reeves had purchased land in Jasper County on 17 October 1818.⁵ As a three year resident of Georgia, Wyatt was eligible to participate in the Third Georgia Land Lottery held in 1820. He won the draw for 250 acres of land located in Early County, Georgia described as Lot 211 of Section 2.⁶

Elizabeth (Sturgis) Reeves Mentioned in Father's Illinois Will — 14 May 1824

A compilation of evidence available to us, clearly shows that Elizabeth Reeves was the daughter of John Sturgis and his wife Anna Wright. Some information on Elizabeth's parents will be given later, but would now like to present an extract from the will of John Sturgis written 14 May 1824 in Sangamon County, Illinois:

".... I have gave and payed my eldest daughter Jane Pattey one feather bedd and furniture, one chestnut sorrel mare worth seventy dollars and some pewter with other articles which she acknowledged to be contented and satisfied with as her full portion of my estate. I have also payed my second child Elizabeth Reaves one feather bedd and some pewter with other articles

as her full share of my estate. I have given unto my third child James Bratton Sturgis one sorrel mare and"

The will record is very significant as it defines the order of the children born to John and Anna Sturgis. A compilation of material on the family helps us understand the events that occurred in the early 1800's while the family lived in South Carolina. The brother James Bratton Sturgis mentioned in above will extract was the subject of an Atlas Map Biography published for Morgan County, Illinois. It stated in part:

".... James B. Sturgis was born in South Carolina, December 7, 1794. He moved to Georgia, and then to Tennessee, and from there, in 1813, he removed to Butler county, Ohio, where he remained until the autumn of 1825, when, with his family, he came to Jacksonville, [Morgan County, Illinois]"

Knowing the birth date for James Sturgis, and considering the normal spacing of children, we concluded that the first two daughters were probably born about 1790 and 1792 respectively. The Jesse Weathers family Bible gave Elizabeth's birth date as 24 May 1792. We had not been able to find any information on the two daughters, Jane Patty [Pate] and Elizabeth Reaves [Reeves], in Illinois records. It is now known that the two sisters probably remained in South Carolina and later moved to Georgia.

Search for Information on Elizabeth Reeves sister - Jane Bratten (Sturgis) Pate

The evidence for Elizabeth Sturgis, wife of Wyatt Reeves, being the daughter of John Sturgis has now been firmly established. But what about her sister Jane Pate? One would assume that the two sisters, being left alone in South Carolina by their parents, would remain close and live in the same locality, wherever that would be. It was on this theory that we began our search to some parents of the problem was that we did not know the full name of her husband nor could we find a marriage or other county record to provide the name.

We first focused on Jasper County, Georgia as our main area of interest because that was where the Wyatt Reeves family lived in 1820, and where he won the draw for land in Early County, Georgia. We noted that there was a James Pate of Jasper County who had also won the draw for 250 acres of land in Early County (Lot 341 of Section 3). There was also an Elijah Pate in Jasper County who won the draw for land in Early County (Lot 145, Section 1). In addition there was another James Pate, who owned land in Jasper County but was a resident of Morgan County, Georgia in 1820. The latter was a widower with orphan children, and he won the draw for land in Irwin County, Georgia (Lot 436 Section 6). The latter was eliminated because we knew Jane Pate was living in 1824, and this same James Pate, whose first wife was named Mary, married second time to Miranda Gay on 21 June 1821 in Jasper County. There were other Pate families listed in Jasper County but they did not meet the next test requirement — the move to Fayette County, Georgia around 1824.

The Move of Reeves and Pate Families to Fayette County, Georgia around 1824

In the search for other land better to his liking, Wyatt Reeves sold his land in Jasper County to Robert Fears on 6 November 18248 and moved to Fayette County, Georgia. There he purchased 202½ acres of new land located in Lot 181, District 4. According to our search criteria Jane Pate and her husband, now believed to be James Pate Jr., should be found living on land near the Wyatt Reeves family. The 1824 Tax Digest for Fayette County, Georgia listed James Pate Sr. and his son James Pate Jr. The latter was taxed for land in Early County, Georgia (Lot 341 Section) mentioned above, and for 101¼ acres of land in Lot 235 District 4 in Fayette County. The latter land was two lots northwest of the Wyatt Reeves land. Since each lot was composed of 202½ acres each, the land was within one mile of the Reeves land — a reasonable distance. We are now searching for records which would show that James Pate Jr. had a wife named Jane as our final test.

James Pate Sr. was taxed for land in Jasper, Henry, Newton, and Fayette Counties, Georgia. His Fayette County land was in Lot 171, District 4. The land was located southeast of the Wyatt Reeves land and the corners of their properties touched each other. Thus we know that both James Pate Sr. and son James Pate Jr. both lived near the Wyatt Reeves property.

Elijah Pate also moved from Jasper County to Fayette County during this period but his land was several miles to the north of Wyatt Reeves. Elijah Pate was listed in the 1840 Fayette County census where he and his wife were both shown to be 40 to 50 years of age. Elijah married a second time just before the 1850 census was taken. Although Elijah Pate was probably related to James Pate Sr. in some manner, we do not believe he was the husband of Jane Bratten (Sturgis) Pate.

The 1830 Fayette County, Georgia census¹⁰ listed James Pate Sr. as between 60 to 70 years of age with no wife listed. There were two young males listed in the household, believed to be children Charles and William Pate. Elizabeth Reeves, widow of Wyatt Reeves, was listed on the same census page.

James Pate Sr. died in 1831 and his property was sold on 18 November 1831. Among the purchasers names listed were Seaborn Pate, James Pate, Charles Pate, B.J. Weems, John Reeves, James C. Davis, and others that we did not recognize. James Pate Jr. was the administrator of his father's estate in Fayette County in 1832. Notes of Charles Pate, Gilbert Gay, William Ward, J.H. Crittendon, Seaborn Pate, Isham Weathers, John Pate and Mrs. [Elizabeth] Reeves, Henry Mitchell and A. McBride were recorded on 6 July 1832. Since the estate record only mentioned ten "Legatees" we do not know their relationship to James Pate Sr. They may in fact have been his sons, but on the other hand, they could have been grandchildren — even children of son James Pate Jr. for which we have found no record. The James Pate will needs to be examined to clarify this point. We know that Jane Bratten Sturgis probably married around 1805, and may have have subsequently had children, but if so, we do not know their names.

It is noteworthy that Seaborn Pate (27 May 1809-28 May 1888), ¹³ died in Fayette County, Georgia and was one of the Legatees of the James Pate Sr. estate. He married Mary Weathers, daughter of Isham Weathers, on 25 October 1827 in Fayette County. Five years later Elizabeth Reeves would marry Mary's brother, Jesse Weathers, on 24 January 1832. Seaborn Pate was taxed in 1834 for 40 acres of land (Lot 181) owned by Elizabeth Reeves. This is mentioned only to show the close relationship of the Pate and Reeves families selected.

James Pate Jr. Chosen as Possible Husband of Jane Bratton Sturgis

In conclusion, after reviewing all the material available to us, we believe that James Pate Jr. was most probably the husband of our Jane Bratten Sturgis. Remember that she was married to a man named Pate on 14 May 1824 according to her father's Illinois will. We would emphasize that we have never seen any mention of a wife named Jane, given as a wife of James Pate or any other Pate. The search for firm evidence continues.

Some Information on Elizabeth's Parents, John and Anna Sturgis

We do not know where Elizabeth's father, John Sturgis, was in 1810 as his name was not listed in the York County census. A Morgan County, Illinois biography¹⁴ on his eldest son, James Bratton Sturgis, who would have traveled with his parents, enlightens us somewhat on the whereabouts of the family on their journey west. This was cited earlier but is repeated here: "James B. Sturgis was born in South Carolina, December 7, 1794. He moved to Georgia, and then to Tennessee, and from there, in 1813, he removed to Butler [Warren] county, Ohio..." John's youngest son, Daniel Bartlett Sturgis, married for second time to Mrs. Rachel Smith 24 January 1886 in Bond County, Illinois at age 74. The license listed his parents as John & Anna (Wright) Sturgis, and gave his birth place as Blount County, Tennessee, which would have been around November 1811. Ironically, this was about the same year that Elizabeth gave birth to her eldest daughter Martha C. Reeves in South Carolina.

Meanwhile, back in Ohio, during this same time period, Elizabeth's parents, the John Sturgis family was listed in the 1820 Census¹⁵ for Sugar Creek Township, Greene County, Ohio near Bellbrook. Upon learning that new lands were soon to be sold in Illinois, the family packed up their possessions, and in 1823 moved to Sangamon County, Illinois where they settled on Richland Creek, northwest of Springfield. Elizabeth's sister, Sarah J. Sturgis [born 17 July 1797 in South Carolina], wife of Gideon Hopping, mentioned the move from Green County, Ohio and her father in a History of Fulton County, Illinois.¹⁶ An extract:

"...Gideon Hopping. He married Miss Sarah J. Sturgis of South Carolina [on 30 October 1817 in Warren County, Ohio and lived in Bath Township, Green County, Ohio in 1820 census]; her father, John Sturges, became known to fame as a Revolutionary soldier and was a living witness of the famous surrender at Yorktown [October 19, 1781]. In 1823 Gideon Hopping and wife, each on horseback, made the western trip to Illinois and stopped near Springfield. In 1836 Mr. H. moved to Fulton Co., settling in Vermont township ... Mrs. H., who is a sister of Dr. Daniel B. Sturgis of South Bend, Ind., the well-known writer and minister of the Gospel..."

Ralph Morgan, husband of Anna Sturges and son-in-law of John Sturgis, was listed in a Poll Book of an election held in the house of William Harrison in Richland Precinct, Sangamon County, Illinois on 2 August 1824,¹⁷ and was reported to be one of the early settlers who lived along Richland Creek in Cartwright Township, Sangamon County, Illinois.¹⁸ The move to Illinois must have been too much for old John Sturgis, who was then about 67 years of age, for his will was dated 14 May 1824 and probated 7 February 1825 in Sangamon County, Illinois.¹⁹ His will named his wife Anna and all his children, including his daughter Elizabeth (see above for extract).

Death of Wyatt Reeves in Fayette County, Georgia about 1827 www.southcarolinapioneers.com

Wyatt Reeves was not to enjoy his Fayette County land purchase long for he died a couple years later, in early 1827, and his estate was probated in Fayette County. The Inventory and Appraisement of the Wyatt Reeves estate was taken on 12 July 1827 and recorded 13 July 1829 in Fayette County. The inventory included farm utensils, one negro woman and child, Lucy and Nancy, and one negro boy, Sam. The appraisers were James Pate (possible brother-in-law, see above for details), William Reeve (brother-in-law), Gilbert Gay, and Barthomew J. Weems (both neighbors).²⁰

The 1827 tax record²¹ for Fayette County listed brother-in-law, William Reeves, paying the taxes for Elizabeth (Sturgis) Reeves, widow of Wyatt Reeves. The tax was paid for lands located both in Early and Fayette Counties described above. Elizabeth was listed by name, sometimes called a widow, and dutifully paid her yearly taxes on these properties through the year 1831. Elizabeth advertised in the Macon Telegraph for the sale of negroes from the Wyatt Reeves estate.²²

The 1830 Census²³ taken for Fayette County listed Elizabeth as 30 to 40 years of age with 6 children, four boys and two girls. Her eldest daughter Martha was not counted as she was then living nearby in a separate household. Martha had married William C. Davis on December 18, 1827 in Fayette County. An unnamed legatee, probably Martha, received 1 bedstead & furniture and one cow and calf from the Wyatt Reeves estate in 1828.²⁴ The lot of land in Early County was sold by Elizabeth Reeves and filed in the estate records 4 May 1829.

The Widow Elizabeth Reeves Marries Jesse Weathers in 1832

Elizabeth's life was soon to change for on the 24th of January 1832 she married a neighbor, Jesse Weathers, and their marriage was recorded in the Fayette County courthouse. The license listed "Mrs. Elizabeth Reeves" as 40 years of age and Jesse just 27 years of age. Jesse Weathers was born in 1805 and Elizabeth was born May 24, 1792 according to the Lee Family Bible record. When the next tax assessment was made in 1832 the tax was paid by Jesse Weathers, and in the 1834 assessment the notation "Admr. in right of wife" was duly noted. It

is not known when they disposed of this land, but they paid their last taxes in Fayette County, Georgia in 1839. Elizabeth's son James Reeves was listed in the 1840 Randolph County, Alabama census.

The final accounting of the Wyatt Reeves estate was made in 1833. The Early County land had been sold, the boarding bills for each child paid, and in the accounting each child was mentioned by name. Generally the children were boarded for 6 years but a couple for a shorter period, i.e., Martha 2 years because of her marriage and Josiah F. for five years as eldest son who became of age. Our records do not tell us when the Weathers family left Fayette County, Georgia and moved to Alabama, but must have been around 1840. Meanwhile back in Illinois Elizabeth's mother Anna Sturgis, the widow of John Sturgis, was listed in the 1830 Census²⁵ taken for Morgan County, Illinois living neighbor to her son-in-law Ralph Morgan, husband of her daughter Anna Sturgis. Ralph Morgan and his brother-in-law William Draper Sturgis purchased adjacent land in Morgan County, Illinois in October 1830.²⁶

Jesse and Elizabeth Weathers Move to Randolph County, Alabama

The 1850 Census for Randolph County, Alabama²⁷ listed Jesse and Elizabeth Weathers, age 45 and 56 respectively, living with their two daughters Mary and Jane Weathers. The following year Elizabeths mother, Anna Sturgis, died in Morgan County, Illinois on 1 February 1851 and her tombstone is in the old Sulpher Springs Cemetery. It gives her birthdate as November 12th, 1767. The cemetery was near the home of Elizabeth's brother John Richardson Sturgis. The 1860,²⁸ and 1870²⁹ Censuses for Randolph County continued to list Jesse Weathers and his two sons-in-law Isham B. Lee and T.V. Barrett.

A descendant from the second marriage, Nancy Lee Bailey, wrote that in several Lee Family Bibles Martha Elizabeth Sturgis was listed only as "Mrs. Elizabeth Reeves", the wife of Jesse Weathers. In the Barrett Family Bible she is listed as "Martha Elizabeth Sturgis". Will Cayolina Process Combe birth and death dates for Elizabeth (24 May 1792 - 13 June 1876) and said that she was buried in Paran Bishop Cemetery, in Randolph County, Alabama. According to Lee family tradition Elizabeth was very secretive about her age—being thirteen years older than Jesse. Elizabeth smoked a pipe as did America Barrett, to the chagrin of some of the Lee family.

The bible record shows that Jesse died 4 May 1875 and Elizabeth died the following year, 13 June 1876, both in Randolph County, Alabama. They are both buried in the Paran Bishop Church Cemetery in Roanoke, Randolph County, Alabama.

SECOND GENERATION

Martha C.2 Reeves (Martha Elizabeth) was born circa 1811, probably in York County, South Carolina. She married William C. Davis 18 December 1827 in Fayette County, Georgia. William was born 5 January 1809 in Georgia. The Davis family was listed in the 183031 and 184032 Censuses for Fayette County, Georgia.

Martha died in September 1859 in New Salem, Rusk County, Texas.33 Following Martha's death her husband William married second Mrs. Miranda Francis Myers Berry 25 October 1860 in Nacogdoches, Texas and had another family. William died years later, 15 October 1886, in Van Zandt County, Texas and was buried in the Foreman Cemetery in Henderson County, Texas.

Josiah F.² Reeves (Martha Elizabeth¹) was born circa 1813, probably in York County, South Carolina. He married Sarah Wilson, widow of William P. Wilson, 6 May 1833 in Fayette County, Georgia. Sarah was born circa 1810 in Georgia. She was probably the widow of William P. Wilson who was deceased by 1 January 1833. After his marriage to Sarah Wilson, Josiah F. Reeves was named as guardian for orphans of William P. Wilson.34 Josiah was listed as age 38 in the 1850 Census for Fayette County, Georgia³⁵ and age 47 in the 1860 Census for Spalding County, Georgia, near Erin.³⁶ Spalding was formed from a part of Fayette County in 1851.

- John Wiley² Reeves (Martha Elizabeth¹) was born December 1819 in Jasper County, Georgia. John was first recorded by name in 1833 when he was named in his father's estate record in Fayette County, Georgia.37 John W. Reeves married Mrs. Sophronia E. Reeves, widow of Dempsey A. Reeves, 7 June 1849 in Fayette County, Georgia. Sophronia was born circa 1829 in Georgia. Sophia [Sophronia] A. Champlin, presumably her maiden name, had been married to Dempsey A. Reeves on 30 January 1844 in Fayette County, Georgia and they had a

daughter Mary Ann Reeves born about 1845. The Dempsey Reeves estate was settled in Fayette County 13 January 1848. The Fayette County Record Book (1830-1850) page 433 had an entry dated 19 November 1849 whereby John W. Reeves was appointed Guardian of Mary Ann Reeves orphan of Dempsey A. Reeves deceased. Mary Ann was listed with the family in both the 1850 and 1860 censuses but was not seen thereafter. John W. Reeves was listed as age 32 born in Georgia [later listed as 40, 50, 60 years of age in later censuses], and living near his mother in the 1850 Census³⁸ for Randolph County, Alabama. The Reeves family was listed in the 1860³⁹ census for Rusk County, Texas, and the 1870⁴⁰ and 1880⁴¹ censuses for Wood County, Texas. His wife Sophronia died in 1880 and John married second Mrs M. J. Scott on 27 February 1881 in Wood County.

Sophronia died 8 November 1880 at Winnsboro, Wood County, Texas and her estate was probated in Wood County. Provisions of the will filed 23 February 1881 left all property in whatever county in Texas to go to husband John W. Reeves. After his death anything left was to go to three minor children of the marriage, John A. Reeves, Columbus C. Reeves, and Anna Reeves. The children of age William A. Reeves, James W. Reeves, Samuel H. Reeves and Thomas J. Reeves had been provided for. Eight years later, 31 August 1888, her husband John W. Reeves died in Campbell, Hunt County, Texas.⁴²

6. William Allen² Reeves (Martha Elizabeth¹) was born 8 November 1821 in Jasper County, Georgia. He married Elizabeth Thornton Bell 8 October 1846 in Fayette County, Georgia. She was born 8 January 1830 in Fayette County, Georgia. William died 20 October 1884 in Texas and was buried in Hillcrest Cemetery, Forney, Kaufman County, Texas. Elizabeth died 5 September 1892 in Forney, Kaufman County, Texas and buried beside her husband in Hillcrest Cemetery.
