

Blocker of Edgefield County, South Carolina

John Blocker, blacksmith, owned two plantations on Log Creek which he and his wife, Julyannay, seamstress, sold on 21 September 1798 for 50 pounds sterling, 325 acres being on Log Creek which was a branch of Turkey Creek of Stevens Creek of the Savannah River and a first and lower tract containing 285 acres of land (the uppermost tract containing 40 acres, the 325 acres being part of 650 acres granted to Hugh Ellision in 1772

John Blocker Sr., born ca 1754, died 1814, his Last Will and Testament being dated 4 September 1814, probated 17 November 1814, named his wife, Juliana (Johnston) and children. Issue:
