Davie of South Carolina



General William R. Davie (1756–1820) was a warrior, orator and statesman. He was married in 1783 to Sarah Jones and after her death in 1805 moved to his large estate located in Landsford, South Carolina where he died in 1820.

- Hyder Ali Davie married Elizabeth Jones of Northampton County, North Carolina. Issue: Julia Davie married Richard Stobo Bedon on 12/30/1830.
- Major Allen Jones Davie married 1st, Mary Wall by whom he had two sons, viz.
 - 1. Dr. William R. Davie, heir of the Landsford estate by the will of his grandfather, married Sarah McKinsie. He died in Alabama. Known issue:
