

## *Gibbes of Charleston, South Carolina*

*Lineage.* "Jenkin Gibbes, of Combe, in the parish of Folkestone, County Kent, descended from the ancient family of Gibbes of Exeter, m. Anne Uden. ". Colonial Families of the United States, Vol. VI by George Norbury Mackenzie.

\*Stephen Gibbes of Bekesbourne, County Kent, born 1562 married 2/10/1585 Jane Turney. Issue:

1. Thomas Gibbes, Councillor of Barbados in 1561
2. Robert Gibbes born 11/27/1594, of Barham, County Kent and afterwards Barbados, married 2/26/1639 Mary Coventry, daughter of Thomas Coventry of Ash. Issue:
  - i. Basil Gibbes, Lieutenant, born 1/9/1640, died 1/16/1687 unmarried.
  - ii. Thomas Gibbes, born 4/24/1642.
  - iii. Alice Gibbes 12/28/1643–10/30/1661, married John Daniel.
  - iv. Robert Gibbes 1/9/1645–1/24/1715, married 2d, Mary.. He settled in South Carolina where he obtained land grants in 1681 and 1682; was Chief Justice of South Carolina in 1708 and Governor from 1709–1712.

- William Gibbes, 1/8/1725-2/20/1780, resident of Charleston, South Carolina, married 1<sup>st</sup>, 3/3/1744, Mary Benison, 2d, 2/12/1748, Elizabeth Hsell (died 6/3/1762), 3<sup>rd</sup>, 10/30/1762, Mary Cook (died 10/1799). He was one of the Secret Committee of Five of the Council of Safety at the beginning of the American Revolution.

He served valiantly in the American Revolution, Capt. Lieutenant of the Ancient Battalion of Artillery at Charleston; fought in Beaufort and Savannah.

Carolina; and was Surgeon General of the State from 1861 to the end of the War Between the States. Issue:
