testament as follows to wit I do leave my some former Wil-
liams all the land that I do possess at my death, and all
my Negroes all so, and my Cattle and horses and all
my Cows sheep and pigs and all my household furniture
and all my plantation tools and the kitchen furniture
and all things belonging to my family sealed and delivered
this 11th day of August 1836. In the presence of
