

Lee of Charleston, South Carolina

Lineage. "Sir Robert Lee, b. at Bridgnorth, Shropshire, England, d. 28th Jan. 1605; Lord Mayor of London, 1602.

Henry Lee, one of the Captains of the City of London (?).

Francis Lee (probably son of above), of Bridgetown, of Barbadoes, bore same coat of arms as Capt. Henry Lee m. Mary (surname unknown).

Thomas Lee of Charleston, S. C., b. at Bridgetown, Barbadoes, 6th Feb. 1710, d. Aug. 1769. Was the first son of Francis and Mary Lee. M. 1st Apr. 1732, Mary Giles of Charleston, S. C., d. 26th May, 1751."

 1. Thomas Lee, 12/1769.–10/29/1839, married Kezia Miles. He was US Judge for South Carolina appointed by President Monroe; also Comptroller–General. Issue:

 - ii. Isaac McPherson Lee (married 1st, Anna Maria Lee, 2d, Dorothea Lee
 - iii. Stephen Lee of Asheville, N. C. married Caroline Lee
 - iv. Thomas Lee, M. D.. He married 1st, Caroline Alison, 2d, Elizabeth Lee Humphreys. He was a graduate of Charleston Medical College and practiced medicine in Abbeville and Anderson District. Issue: Caroline Kezia Rachel Lee, born 1835, married Captain Samuel Hunter; Stephen Dill Lee, Lieutenant–General, C. S. A., born 9/22/1833 Charleston, died 5/28/1909 in Vicksburg, Mississippi married 2/9/1865 Regina Lilly Harrison; Lawrence Lee killed at Battle of Murfreesboro; Leroy Alison Lee born 2/16/1848; Arthur St. Clair Lee of Greenwood City, S. C., b. 2/8/1850 in Anerson Co., S. C., married at Greenwood, S. C. on 12/21/1875 Ella B. Hodges, daughter of Samuel Anderson and Mary Dorothy (Conner) Hodges of Cokesburg, South Carolina.
