Sallie, or (Sara K.), married William Aiken, January 1, 1824, in Elbert County, but afterward lived in Monroe County and her children were: Jerusia, Jenny, Sara, Ida, William and Saphronia, who married William Jackson Wilder. She had one son, Henry, who lived at Forsyth, Georgia, and one of his daughters, Gladys, married Dr. Smith, of Swainsboro, Georgia.

Thomas Mann, son of John Mann, was an old bachelor, lived and died in Monroe County.

Asa Mann was a doctor and lived at Forsyth, Georgia, married Millie Oliver, September 6, 1832; he was married twice but had no children.

John J. Mann was born January 13, 1797, and died February 10, 1841; his wife, Mary R. Harper, was born February 25, 1796, and died September 27, 1870, and was buried at Griffin, Georgia; they were married December 26, 1816. Their children were: R. F. M., born October 26, 1816, died in 1886; he was a great singer, and composed many pieces of music found in the old Sacred Harp. # HISTORY OF MANN FAMILY

The name Mann (or Man, the different spellings are used interchangeably) belongs to families of Welsh, Dutch, German and French ancestry. The only one in which the spelling has been unchanged is the German—Mann, meaning the same as Herr, signifying the masculine. The French Mann, or Manno, as does the Dutch Mann, means man or manly; however, the Welsh has a different meaning. In this language it signifies freckled or spotted, also a spot or place.

The surname is first mentioned in England in the Domesday Book, the oldest record in England. In this book in 1086 was recorded the name Willimus filius Manne, meaning William, the son of Man. He appears as a landholder in County Hants. However, the principal seat of the family was at Bramley, Yorkshire. Various members of the family received knighthood and were given estates in other countries, but as shown by the suffix, or on coats-of-arms, these were all of the same branch. The American Manns, that is, those who settled in this country in the sixteenth century, came principally from the counties of Kent and Norfolk, England.

The Manns early settled in Virginia, Massachusetts and Rhode Island. The earliest record of a Mann in Virginia goes back to the original stockholders of the Virginia Company. A Percival Mann died in Virginia about 1623, having been one of its earliest settlers. He left no descendants, however, so the founders of the first branches of this family in Virginia were William and Thomas Mann, evidently brothers, who at the time that they came to America from London (June 6, 1635) in the ship "Thomas and John," William was twenty-five and Thomas twenty-three.

The oldest seat of the Manns in Virginia was at Timberneck (sometimes spelled Timber's Neck) in Gloucester County. As shown by an authentic coat-of-arms this family was a branch of the distinguished old family of England. The Manns played an important role in the early history of Virginia as shown by constant references to them in the various histories of the times, including the William and Mary Quarterly, Tyler's

Quarterly, the Edward Pleasants Valentine Papers (many of them referred to this work, telling the counties in which they lived), and the Virginia Magazine.

As the original Manns in Virginia lived on the Bay at Timberneck, it is very probable that some of them took to the sea. The first of the family in South Carolina, Captain Thomas Mann, was a sea captain, and as shown by his coat-of-arms, was related to the Manns of Virginia. He was living in St. Andrews Parish, near Charleston, in 1698, and was prominent in the social life that was prominent in the aristocratic section. Various references are made to the family in South Carolina works of history. James Mann served in Colonel Thomson's Regiment of Rangers in South Carolina during the Revolution. The South Carolina Historical Magazine shows him to be in the service in September of 1775 and to be registered from South Carolina. Various other references are made in this work to the Mann Family, often the name being spelled Man. However, it is all the same family, as evidenced by the same person show.

## RECORD OF MANN FAMILY IN SOUTH CAROLINA AND GEORGIA

Searching the Newberry, S. C. records in regard to the Mann family, we find there was a Robert Mann, who lived and died in the vicinity of Newberry, S. C. Robert Mann made his will in 1782, showing he had three sons, namely: James, John and Robert Mann. Records show that John Mann, son of the above Robert Mann, and Robert Mann, Jr., lived and died in the vicinity of Newberry, S. C. John had four sons, namely: Henry, Robert, John and James, and we did not find Robert Mann's family. James Mann, son of the first mentioned Robert Mann and his wife Judith Mann, lived in South Carolina until the latter part of the 17th century. He was in the Revolutionary War in 1776; moved to Elbert County, Georgia, and lived near Buckersville on the Savannah River.
