In the Name of God Amen the first day of February in the Year of  
 our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred & Seventy Four I William Turner  
 of Saluday & in the district of Ninety Six & Province of  
 South Carolina being very Sick & Weak of body but of Perfect  
 Mind & Memory Thanks be given unto God therefore calling unto  
 Mind the Mortality of my Body & Knowing that it is Appointed for  
 all men Once to Die do make & Ordain this my Last Will and Testa-  
 ment that is to say Principally & first of all I give and Rec-  
 ommend my Soul into the Hands of God that gave it and as for my  
 Body I Recommend it to the Earth to be Buried in a Christian Like  
 & Decent Manner at the Discretion of my Executrix, Nothing Doubt-  
 ing but at the General resurrection I shall receive the same again  
 by the Mighty Power of God and as such Worldly Estate where-  
 with it hath pleased God to bless me in this Life. I give ad-  
 vice & dispose of the same in the following Manner and form Item  
 I give to my well beloved Son William Turner One Tract of Land  
 Lying on the Reaver Dam Containing One Hundred & fifty Acres, Known by the Name of the Pigeon Roost & One Negro Boy Named James  
 to him & his Heirs for ever. Item I give to my well Beloved Son  
Richard Turner One Shilling Sterling. Item I give to my well  
 Beloved Son John Turner One Tract of Land Containing two Hund-  
 red Acres Known by the Name of Ramptons One Negro Boy Named Sam  
 & One Negro Girl Named Nell to him & his Heirs for ever. Item I  
 give to my well beloved Son Edward Turner two hundred Acres of  
 Land it being the upper end of a Tract Land laid out for John  
 Page & One Negro Boy Named Isaac to him & his Heirs for ever. Item I give to my well beloved Son Absalom Turner One Half of a  
 Tract of Land formerly laid out for William Sinkfield containing  
 four Hundred Acres the Lower end for Absalom & the upper end for  
 my Son David Turner to be equally Divided by a Line from the River  
 to the back Line to them & their Heirs & Affigns for ever. Item I  
 give to my well beloved Son Absalom Turner One Negro Boy Named  
 to him his Heirs & Affigns for ever. Item I give unto my well Belo-  
 ved Son David Turner One Negro boy Named Monday to him his heirs  
 & Affigns for ever. Item I give unto my well Beloved Daughter Mary

her & her Heirs Lawfully begotten of her Body & also One Negroe  
woman Named Clee her & her Increase to her & her Heirs Lawfully  
begotten of her Body for ever- Item I give to my well Beloved  
daughter Ann Almey two Hundred & fifty Acres of Land it Being  
the upper Part of a Tract of Land Laid out for Bcock Anderson  
which she now lives on & One Negroe Girl Named Flora to her &  
her Heirs of her Body Lawfully Begotten for ever- Item I give  
unto my well Beloved Daughter Elizabeth Stevens two Hundred  
Acres of Land that she now Lives on & One Negroe Girl Named Mary  
to her & her heirs Lawfully Begotten of her Body for ever Item  
I give unto my well Beloved Daughter Deborah Turner three Hundred  
Acres of Land on Little River Joining to Land of Gilbert Turner  
& One Negroe Girl Named Sarah to her & her Heirs Lawfully Begotten  
of her body for ever Item I give unto my well beloved Daughter  
Priscilla Turner two Hundred & fifty Acres of Land which I now  
live on at this time a forty Nine Acres Joining it & One Negroe  
Girl Named Beck to her & her Heirs lawfully begotten of her Body  
for ever- Item I give unto my Grand son William Turner the Son  
of Richard Turner One Hundred Acres of Land off from the lower  
end it being Part of a Tract of Land Laid out for John Page to  
be laid off by a Strait Line from the River to the Back Line &  
Eighty three Acres Joining it & all things Mentioned in a Bill of  
Sale from Richard to me & One Negroe Named Harkles to him & his  
Heirs for ever- Item I Leave all the rest of my Lands & Negresses  
to my Loving Wife Elizabeth Turner During her Natural Life to be  
disposed of at her discretion she Paying my Just Debts whom I  
Likewise Constitute make & Ordain my Only & Sole Executrix of this  
my Last Will & Testament & I do hereby Disallow revoke & disannul  
all and every other former Testaments Wills Legacies & Executors  
by me in any wise before this time Named Willed & Bequeathed Rat-  
ifying & Confirming this & No other to be my Last Will & Testa-  
ment. In Witness I have hereunto set my Hand & Seal the day and  
Year above written
