to say I will that all My just and Lawfull Debts funeral Charges and Expenses be paid by My Executors herein after Named Item I give and Bequeeth unto My Dear and Loving wife Jennie Edwards I give to her during life certain track of Land with I purchased of--Josches salvadore Containg sixty acres Likewise too Cows and calfs horses and saddle one feather bed and firneture at his disposal and all my other property to Be sold at publick sale the money arising from the same to Be Equally divided Between my wife and my two daughters Leale and Elizabeth Edwards and if either of my two said daughters should decese under age or without anissue then her part is to fall to heir sisters other sister and in case that both my daughters should decese without an issue then their part to be given to Thomas Edwards second and third doughtters Rebeca and Jenny Edwards I--do--otherwise--I do confide otherwise and apppoint Thomas Edwards James Lockridge and Matthew Edwards my true and Lawful Executors to Execute this my Last will and testament whair unto I have set my hand and seal this third day of April and in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundread and Ninty one
