A. Hathorn~~. Secondly I give and Bequeath to my Beloved grand son Robert Campbel Gordan that plantation purchased by me from Andrew Kirkpatrick ~~lying in Abbeville County~~ also an Equall Divide of my Houshold furniture and Cattle and one horse betwixt the said Robert Campbel Gordan; and my Beloved grand son Robert "icholson "athorn; Thirdly I give and bequeath unto my Beloved grand Daughter Ann Kirkpatrick all my Body Cloathes Except one Chintz Coat not made upp one Chintz Gowen which I Bequeath and also one womans saddle and Bridle which I give unto Ann Ha thorn my Beloved grand Daughter together my Red Cloak It is my will and Desire that Alexander Hamilton and Robert Gilmore ~~Executors of this my Last Will and Testament~~
