Anne the Boath real and Personal ugntill my only Son James Alexander, Shall arive to the age of Ewenty years -- Except So much as Shall pay my Just Debts and Educate my Said Son James Alexander, and Then he the Said James Alexander Shall arive to the Said I wenty years of age that then the whole of my Personal Estate be Equally Divided Between my -- Beleved Wife Anne and my only Son James Alexander tothem and their Heirs Forever and also that my Dearly Releved -- wife anne Shall have the use of one third Part of my Land During her Life and that The Said Anne Shall five up the Other-two thirds of the Said Land when my Said Son Shall arive to the -- Said Term of Twenty years of age, and I do hereby and Hereunto -- appoint and Ordain Alexander Clark. & Fleming Bates Executors to this my Last will and Testament Ann Bates , and do hereby -- Disannul and revoke all Former Wills and Legacys and do hereby confirm this and no Other as my Last will and Testament in Witness Whereof I have Set my hand and Seal this 25th day of Angust 1788 --
