JAMES CALHOUN, Sen.^r

In the name of God Amen I James Calhoun sen.^r of Ninety six in Abbeville County in the State of South Carolina Planter being of sound and disposing mind and hereby make publich and declare this to be my last Will and Testament in writing hereby revoking and making void all former and other Wills by me heretofore at any time made, first of all I do hereby devise and direct my ex-ecutors hereafter named and appointed to give my beloved wife a sufficient Maintinance of the Estate I am now posses.^d of or in-titled unto, while she lives unmarried I will and bequeath also unto my wife Jennet and Alexander Calhoun Moody one note of hand which is upon John Gaws of one hundred Pounds old Currency with the lawful Interest of the same for the use of them and also I will and bequeath unto her Two Cows and Calfs and Two small Steers and one sorrel mare with a blafe face and to the above named Moody I will and bequeath one Cow and Calf and one three year old heffer with one black two year old mare--Item I will and bequeath unto James Calhoun son of John Calhoun's all my Lands with half the Grift mill and half the saw mill, also which I am now posessed of--Item I give and bequeath unto my son Wil-liam one Negroe man named Sambo--Item I give & bequeath to And-rew Chalmers one sorrel stalling Colt with one Two year old hef-fer of a White and brindled Colour. Item I give and bequeath unto *James Calhoun, son of William Calhoun's Faction* my daughter Martha thirty nine pounds old currency that is now in your own hand, Item I give and bequeath unto William Ander-son my soninlaw one Dollar--In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this ninth day day of May 1786--
