I Will and Beqeth unto Christopher Brooks My lawfull heir three  
cows and tow calves twow Horses all the rest of the goods and  
Chattles Belonging to the Estate Exclusive of his Part  
Signd seald and Deliverd in the P<sup>r</sup>esence of Us in the Year of our  
Lord one thousand Seven hundred Ninty six Jan<sup>y</sup> the 8 Day
