IN THE NAME OF GOD, Amen, I Andrew Cowan of Abbeville County Ninety Six District, being Weet of Body, 22 77 2 perfect Memory, thanks Be to God for his Mercies; But Considering the frailty of all flesh I Lock upon it as my Duty to Dispose of Such a State, as God has Been pleased to Lend me for the Better quitting my Concience; as in the Manner following; first of all; I give my Soul to God the Giver; and my Body to the earth to Be Decintly Buried, at the Diseation of my Legatees ---Next all My Debts to be paid, By my Executors hereafter Named--first of all I Leave and Bequeath unto my bloved wife, Ann Cowanand to me don John Cowan, the plantation I give on, with all the Goeds and Chatters, to Benain their Real property as hong as they Live together: But in Case that either of them Marry or any separation Comes Between them, my sib John is to have one hundred series Likewise I Leave and Bequeath to my Son William one hundred adverse Land Lying on the Northwest Side of this plantation; that I new Live upon; and all the over plus of Land that demains more than Williams of my three Last Surveys I heave to my son John Likewise I give and Bequeath unto my Son Isaac the hundred acres of Land that Lyeth up the Creek on the Nor east side. Leave and Bequeath my old plantation of Bounty hand to Be equally Divided Between my Beloved wife and my four Daughters---my Manghter Mary Elizabeth Ann and Leaney Cowan at the Direction of my Guardiane; again I heave/ the mares and Colts that my Sons Claims to Be their unalterable property; Also it is my will that my Son John & Isauc Shall Give my Daugheer Mury a horse or a mare valued to ten pounds Sterling our of their part. of their Land, the above Goods and Chattles are to Remain at the Disposal of my Executors or Guardiene, to Be Divided at their Discretion, it is my will also that the Schooling of all my Children And the payment of All my Debts Comes of the Whole; this I declare to Be my Last Will and testament----I Appoint Ann Cowan and John Cawan to be my sole Executors
