I James Grozier Do Leave and Bequeath unto my wife and two Children that is to Say Samuel Croasier and agnes Croasier all my worldly Substance To be Equally Divided In three parts and Each of them to Receive alike and alike except my two Plantations a hunder ackre In Each of them I Leave and bequeath to my Son Samuel Croasier over and above the Rest I order my wife to Live on the Plantation and do Injoy the Benefits of all During her wedohed but at her marriage She is to Leave my Plantation Clear and to Receive her part I ordain ~~point was Proved~~ and Thomas Crozier to by my whole and Seall Executors to this my Last will and Testament Given under my hand and Seall this 27 day of May In the year of our Lorde 1778:
