Hext, That his son James shall have the plantation on which the family now lives.

Next, That his son George Washington shall have the plants-

Next, that the child of which his wife is now pregnant, if a daughter, shall have his negro wench Tab; & that his Regro fellow Jame shall be sold in such a manner as the executors may judge to the best advantage, & his price divided equally emong the three children; but if a son, he shall have the weach Tab & the whole price of Jame.

Next, That Capt. John Norwood shall see to a certain suit of him the said Groege Aiddell, now depending in Abbeville Court.

Laftly, That Capt. John Norwood & Mofes Liddell shall be executors of this his laft will & teftement.
