county aforesaid, being weak of Body

but sound of Memory do this 23^d day of May 1796 Make and publish
this my last Will and Testament in the Manner Following Viz---
First I, allow, give and bequeath to my Eldest son Henry Gable
one Hundred acres of ^{land} ~~land~~ bought from Wm. Dorrus, and Granted to
said Henry only said Henry is to pay my son Jacob Gable ten
pounds sterling Secondly I give to John Gable my 2^d son one
Hundred acres bought of Wm. Hutton he also paying ten pounds of
said Money to Harmon Gable my fourth son, ~~Third~~ ^{Third} I allow and
Desire my wife Margret Gable as long as she lives a widow to keep
all my good & Chattles and all movable property and to give Each
child an Equal share Henry Excepted & him also if he duly pays
Jacob the above Named ten pounds if not to have nothing more
than five shillings sterling than Jacob to have Henry's share
of the Movabbe property, Fourthly, I also Require and allow xxx
if Henry or John should Die without and Heir, there share of ~~land~~
to be Equally Divided between Jacob & Hermon, and if Jacob or
xxxx Germon die the other is to have his part, also I allow my
wife before named if Marrying to have the third of my Movable
property, and again I allow Each Child coming of age or Marrying
then to Receive his or her share--- Lastly I ordain and allow
Henry Gable and Margret Gable my wife to be my sole Executors
for to see this my will fully Executed for the true Intent &
meaning thereof. The said Hermon Gable have to this my last
will and Testament set my hand and seal the day and year above
Written--
