

WILL OF

JACOB DELECHAUX

In the Name of God Amen, I Jacob Delechaux of Hillsborough Township Abbeville County Blacksmith being sickly & weak but sound of Memory and knowing that we must all die, I have ordained this to be made as my last will and Testament, concerning my terrestrial Estate of which it has pleased God to grant me in this world, I dispose give & bequeath same, in the following manner viz

1^o. I give & bequeath, first to my beloved spouse Elizabeth Delechaux all my household furniture one horse, and the enjoyment of my lands till her Death & also all my hogs & plantations tools

2^o. I give & bequeath to my beloved Son James--Delechaux the half of my lands after the Death of my said spouse and the other half to my beloved Son Peter Delechaux with a cow & Calf-----

3^o. I give & bequeath to my Step Son Charles Brett one cow & Calf-----

4th. The Remainder of my Cattle shall be divided between my three Daughters Susanna Delechaux Sara Delechaux Elizabeth Delechaux & my young youngest Son Jacob-----

5^{thly} I give a Compleat Sett of Smith's tools to be Sold to Satisfy my Creditors in paying of my just Debts & if any remains I give it to my spouse Elisabeth Delechaux & also the Debts due to me by account or otherwise; but if the sett of Said Smith tools

should not suffice to pay the Debts what is due to me Shall be put to that effect & to the expence of my burrial: And I have Names & name for Executors of this my last will & Testament my beloved spouse Elisabeth Delechaux; and by this intirely disapprove and revoke and annul all others form of Testament & legats & Executors; by me in all sort of manner before named legued or left by Testament, Ratifying & confirming this & no other as being my last will & Testament. In witness whereof I have Signed & Sealed with my own hand this Seventeenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & Ninety
