 I do make this my last Will and Testament in the manner and--
 form folowing, Viz. I give my Soul to God Who gave it and my
 body to the Earth from whence it Was taken to be Buried in a
 decent and Christain like manner at the discreation of my Exe-
 cutor hereafter mentioned, I give and Bequeath to my Son Joseph--
 Bealy one Hundred acres of Land of the plantation I now Live on
 a Joining to John Bowie plantation, Ittm I give Unto my son Na-
 thaniel Bealey the Remainder of my Plantation Which is one hund-
 red and fifty five acres I give him all my horses
 Creators and Cows Except them after Mentioned, and-----
 Nathaniel Bealey is to Maintain and suport his sister Isabal
 Bealey and Her horses and Cows as long as she Remains Unmarried,
 and I give and Bequeath Unto Nathaniel Bealy and Isabal Bealey all
 my house-hold furniture to be Equally Divided between them, Except
 the Crook and pot Which is--Nathaniels own property, Ittm, I give
 Unto Jean-Thakes my grand-daughter Jean Thaker one Cow and Calf
 and one Steer known by the Name of Jean Thakers; and I Constitute
 and Appoint my son Nathaniel Bealey to be my Executor of this my
 last Will and Testament, and I Revoke and disanul all former Wills
 and testaments, and I pronounce and Declenr this to be my last
 Will and testament this fourteenth Day of February in the Year of
 our Lord--one Thousand seven hundred and Eighty-----
