JAMES BROWNLIE

In name of god amen the 20 of July 1789 I James brownlee of the state of south Carolina In ninty six district planter being very sick in body but of good and perfect memory thanks be to Almighty god for it and calling to remembrance the Uncertainty of this transitory life and that all flesh Must die when it shall please god to Call them Do make and declare this my last will and testament In manner and form following first being penent and sory for all my sins most humbly desiring forGivness for the same I commend my soul un to Almighty god my saviour and redeemer in whom And by whos merita i trust and believe to be Saved my body I commit to the Earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors herafter Named and for the settling of my temperl state And such good chattels and dbts as it hath pleased God to be stow upon me I do order and give and dispose the same in manner and form following And first I lave to my son willam one hundred Eakers of lan to my daughter Elezebth one hundred Eakers of lan jecing willam and to my son James one hundred and sixtysix Eakers of ~~lan~~ where I now live to my son willam two cows and a uter the remainder of the cattel to Bee devided between bety and James I give the Negro fridy to my son ~~James~~ and to my son James the chist with the lock and to my son James all the plantation tools to my son James all the horses and mares and he to give betty one hors the puter to be Devided between bety and James and to my son George I lave half a crown I likwis constitute make and ordain Joseph Brownlee and John Richey to be Sos Executers of this my last will and testamen and I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and all and every other form of Wills and confirming this and no other to be my last will and testament in Witness whereof I have heere unto set my hand and seal this 20th July 1789

James and to my son George I lave half a crown I likwia constitute  
make and ordain Joseph Brownlee and John Richey to be Sos  
Executers of this my last will and testamen and I do hereby  
utterly disallow revoke and all and every other form of Wills and  
confirming this and no other to be my laut will and testament in  
witnesse whereof I have heere unto set my hand and seal this 21
