And what it has pleased the Almighty to endow me with it is my will & desire shall be Disposed off in the following manner (Viz) If my Debts can be collected my son in law Wm Sample shall have two hundred Dollars and if my Debts is not collected he shall have in propotion of what is collected the balance I give unto my Daughter Mary Houston. I do Hereby appoint William Sample John Meriwether Executors & my Daughter Mary Houston Exectrix to my last will & Testament as Witness my hand this 9th day
