In the name of God amen I James Noble of the State and county aforesaid, being weak of Body, but of sound mind and memory Blessed be god, do this fifth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety Six, make and publish this my last will and testament in manner following (that is to say) imprimis I give to my beloved wife Mary anne one Negro Woman named Sarah my will also is that my beloved wife hold and Enjoy one third part of my Land including my dwelling house and clear lands During her Life or widowhood as also one third part of my moovable Estate During her Life or widowhood including the value of the Negro woman Sarah which said negro ~~is intended to be given in feesimple, my will further is that~~ my Two Sons James and John shall have the whole of my lands after the death or marriage of my Beloved Wife, it being Equally Divided Between them my will further is that the whole of my moovable Estate be Equally Divided between My four Children Viz James, John, Mary and Sarah when they come to age, my will further is that my outstanding debts and Ready money be applied to wards the Education and maintainance of my Children and wife to be used in the Family at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named My will further is that at the death or marriage of my beloved wife, the whole disposal of my children be in my Executors, towit. my Beloved Brother Alexander Noble and my Trusty friend Joseph Calhoun who I appoint to Execute this my last will and testament in Witness wherof I have set my hand and Seal this day and year above written
