ty of this mortal life Do make & Publish this my last will &
testament in manner following Viz-

First I Do give & bequeath unto my beloved Wife Anne Bole the
one half of the Land on Which I now live to be hers during her
life also one horse And two Cows together w^t all my Stock of
hogs Plantation tools & Houshold Furniture To be for the use
of the family Next I Do give & bequeath to My Son Henry Bole
fifty Acres of Land as also his mothers part at her Death
Together with his Mare & Saddle & a cow & ~~also~~
give & bequeath To my Son Isaac Bole fifty Acres of land Next
I Do give & bequeath To John Carlile Isaac C: Bole And^v Wilson
& Mary Ward one heifer Each, And to the Rest of my Sons & Son-
inlaws five Shill Each & I Do Appoint W^m: Bole & Ja^s: Carlile
Executors of this my last Will & testament Signed and Sealed
this 31st Day of October In the year of our Lord 1795
