I John Chambers Sen. of the State of My Carolina And county
of Abbeville-being Weak in body, but of sound mind and memory,
thanks be to god--Calling to mind the Mortality of my body and
knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die--do make and
Ordain this My Last Will and Testament--That is to say--
Principally and First of all I give and recommend my Soul into
the Hands of almighty who give it-- and my Body I recommend to
the Earth to be Buried in decent Burial at the discretion of my
Executors--and as touching my Worldly Estate wherewith it has
pleased god to bless me in this Life--I give, demise and Dispose
of the same in the manner and form following-----
First I give and Bequeath to my Beloved son John Chambers one
shilling sterling--also To my Beloved Daughters--Elizabeth Kile--
Mary Patterson and Hemiah Pankey--Each, one shilling sterling,
to be Raised out of my Estate---also I give and Bequeath to my
beloved son Stephen Chambers One Negroe Man--Slave Named Jo.
and the sum of Ninety pounds Virginia money due to me from
James Cooke--also the sum of Thirty six pounds seventeen shil-
lings Like money, due to me by Charles Anderson, with the In-
terest due on Each--also--I give and Bequeath unto my Beloved son
Josiah Chambers One Negroe Girl Named Lydia, also the sum of One
Hundred and fifty pounds Virginia money due to me from my Son
John Chambers, with the Interest due on Each--Also I give and Be-
queath unto my Beloved Daughter Sally Chambers Two Negroes Named
Jack and Bet Also I give unto my Beloved Son, Pie Chambers--
One Negroe Boy Named Charles--Also I give unto my beloved Dau-
ghter Anne Chambers Two Negroes Named Jean & Frank a Negroe gal
fan Also I give and Bequeath unto my Beloved wife Agness
Chambers all the Remaining part of my Estate--during
her Widdowhood, after paying all my just debts--and at her
decease the whole to be Equally Divided between my three Sons,
Stephen, Josiah, & Pie Chambers--and I do hereby Nominate Con-
stitute and appoint my beloved wife Agness Chambers and my Be-
loved sons Josiah & Stephen Chambers to be the whole and sole
Executors of this my Last Will and Testament

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hereby utterly disallow, Revoke and Disannull all Former wills
& Testaments by me made--Ratifying and confirm this and this
Only To be my Last Will and Testament

Twenty fifth day of February in the year of our Lord One thousand
seven Hundred & Ninety Two--
