District in the province of South Carolina, planter being sound of memory and mind, and Body, Blessed be God - Knowing that we are all mortalls , and the houre of our Death Unknown to us, I have tought proper to Draw this my Last vill and Testament, in order to prevent all disputes and quarels Concerning the Small Terrestrial State, that the all Myghty God hath been please to bless me with, so I order that all my State be disposed after my Death, in the forms and maner hereafter specified, that is to say, after my Death, my body to be decentely buried if possibly be, and all my Dept truly and faithfully paid, if any there should be, and all my State Real and personall, to be sold at public Sale, to the best bider, and all the money or moneis there arisen, to be conveyed to my Dear beloved Brother John Emerie, and my Dear beloved Sister Henrie Eymerie, married to Peter des champ to whom two I be quit all my State Real and personal, in Equal shear and portion, of all what may be Raised from my said state after all my Lawfull Depts and Expenses as well for siknes or buriel and others, that I may be obliged to make or Cause to be made my suport, be all truly p and faithfully paid; and as I was Lawfully married to Angelica Elizabet Baor the Daughter of Adam Baor of hard labor, of this District, and she without Reason or provocation whatsoever hath Eloped from my bed and boarding, and assoziated herself with one vagabond, to Rob me of all my Effects and caried them off withthem, and being discovered, to avenge herself, and satisfy her Lust and ambition, had Come divers times with divers othre vagabonds, Robed my house, and treating my Life firing guns tourough my house in www.southcarolinapioneers.net

property to be sold as aforesaid at publik sale, and the money from it raised, to be imployed, first, to pay all my Lawfull Dept and Expenses, and Legaly to my Executors, hereafter specified, all the Rest I bequit to my Dears beloved Brother and Sister, John and Henrie Eymerie for their proper use of them and their heirs; and for the Execution of this my Last vill and Testament I have Named and Name M^r Peter Moragne of Long Cane in the District of Ninety Six Planter and M^r Francois Gros, of Charlestown, formerly Taverne Kepper, to Whom, I give and bequit the Sum of fifty pounds Curently or Seven pounds Sterling, Each, to be Levyed, as the Depts and Expences aforesaid, and this Legacy is as for the Love trust and confidence I repose on them for their faithfull administration, besides their Reasonable fees and Expenses I give full power and authority to the Said M^r Peter Moragne and M^r Francois Gros, to act and to do with all my state and chatel and money from them arisen to sell and order to be sold all the said my State, and to Convey all the money from it arisen, to my Dear beloved Brother and Sister aforesaid all the Remainder, after all the Lawfull Dept and Expenses, and Legacy paid out I said all the Remainder to be faithfully Conveyed at and to the aforesaid my Dear beloved Brother and Sister, and John Henrie Eymerie my proper Lawfull heirs and the only my Lawfull heirs, and this I approve and confirme for my vill and Testament, as my Last Deed of Vill, and by this I Revoke and intirely disapprove and Revoke and anull all other former vill or Testaments or deed of vill by me made if any there should have been made, and Confirme this present and no other, as this, and only this, I intend to be my Last Vill and Testament, and deed of Last vill, I WITNESSED, to be and intended to be firme and Irrevocable, I Signed it and Witnessed it with my proper hand and Sealed it With my seal this Tenth Day of February in the year
