sterling Also my ~~Also~~ my silver shoe Buckles Also I order that
all My Debts Be punctually paid and My funeral Expences Discharged,
and the remainder I give To My son Thomas C Miller--

Also I Order that all my Effects Be sold and an acct. Given of them
to My son Tho.^s Miller-----

I Order that if any of the above Named Children Thomas Mil-
ler and Agness should die that the other should have the Whole
and if they Both should Die I order that My Brother William Mil-
ler Get it By Coming and Brining Lawful Authority for the same.

And I do hereby Constitute and Appoint Robert---Henderson and
James White the sole Executors of this My last will and Testament
In Witness whereof I have hereunt set My hand and seal this 14th
Day of April--in the year of our Lord 1793
