~~veniency will permit by private Sale and my desire is that~~
my family Stay together upon Plantation on which they now
live as long as they can in peace and quietness and the
moveable property which I now possess I will and order that
it be Sold at Publick Sale to the highest Bidder and that
my Loving wife Eliza both shall have her third part of the
income of such Sale and that the remainder Shall be equally
devived between my three Sons Samuel Norwood Porter Hugh
Porter and John Porter and I do hereby appoint my friend
James Watts Executor and my wife Eliza both porter Executrix
of this my Last will and Testament and I Will that it be re-
ceived by all as Such and I do hereby mak void and Null all
former Wills and Testaments by me made IN WITNESS whereof
I do hereby Set my hand and Seal this 27th day of December
