Samuel Rosemond James Rosemond, Margeret Weems, & Sarah Hoges and I do make and ordain My Loveing Brother Samuel Rosemond Sole Executor of this my Last will in Witness whereof I do hereunto set my hand and Seal this Eleventh day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & Ninety three
