JOHN WALLER her and her heirs forever-Item- it is my desire that all my children should rule slaves I have given & right & not part man & wife among them if they can prevent Item-I desire that at my wife's death my land Stock of different kinds & houshold furniture etc, should be sold be sold on twelve months credit allowing my Son Thomas Baxter the bene fit of raising one grop on the field adjoining whe line of Mr. John Chiles & that my Executors make legal titles to the purshaser of my land win case either of my Executors is the purchaser that the other or others Executors make him a legal title for the said Three hundred & Twenty acres of land with its appurtenances excepting the gin house & its appurtenances which is to be removed by the partners & the money arising from the Sales aforesaid I give & beq ueath in equal aivision among my nine Children before mentioned & the survivors of them & their heirs forever -Item as I have given a horse or make to three of my children according to their several choices I would be understood to give but one to each of them-- ST I CITED SECON Lastly I nominate constitute & appoint my beloved wife Elizabeth during her winowhood my Executerx & my three Sons Benjamin, John Nichademus & Thomas Baxter Executors of this my last will & testament In Witness whereof I have hereinto set my hand & seal this Eleventh day of Pecember 1801-.
