Rest of my Estate my Land - live on my horses Cattle Sheep hogs
withall my household Goode untill my Son James Wilson Comes to
Lawful age - then there to be an Equal Division of my
Whole Estate between my Wife Ruth Wilson, John Wilson Jacob Wilson
Betsy Wilson and James Wilson to them and their heirs for ever.
I Do Appoint my Loving wife Ruth Wilson and my friend Jacob
Clark to be the exetors of this my Last will and testament in
witness my hand and seal this 30 Day of August 1796
