WILLIAM LITTLE

In the name of God Amen. I William Little of the County of Abbeville and State of South Carolina, Weaver, being of perfect mind and memory make this my last Will and Testament--First after the payment of the expence of a decent burial of my Corps, after my deceas, and the discharge of my other just debts--I give and bequeath to Mary Little, Alias, Smith the sum of one Shilling Sterling--Also I give and bequeath to my Daughter Anne Little one shilling Sterling--The Residue and remainder of my Estate, Lands, tenements hereditaments, with my goods, Charries, bonds, arrears of rent, with all other properties whatsoever to me appertaining, I give, devise and bequeath to my son John Little planter, whom I do hereby appoint and appoint the whol and sole Executor of this my Last Will and Testament, and I do hereby utterly revoke, disallow and disannul all former bequests, Wills and Legacys by me heretofore in anywise left or made, declaring ratifying and confirming this, and no other, to be my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal, this 4th Day of September, in the year of our Lord 1788--
