husband one Cow and Calf which is thier possession, one Mare and  
the Remainder of my property will be Sold to pay my Debts and  
debts  
the money if any whick should be left from paying my / to be  
Divided into three equal parts and my Daughters Jean and Rachel  
to have each a part, and my Daughters Mary McGee and Betty  
Clark and their husbands the other third part equally amongst them  
I Constitute James Wadsworth and my Daughter Ann Executors of this  
my last will and Testament in witness whereof I set to my  
hand and Seal this twentyfirst Day of July in the year of our  
Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight 23 year of the  
american Independence
