Plantation; heris to pay to My Childer then Living male and Feamale an Equal part of the Valuation, his own part Excepted, and all the personal goods that is my Wife time of her Decease (she Remaining single from my Decease Until then in interest shall be Equally Divided many between my Children male and Feamale. And I make and Ordain her my said Wife Sole Executrix of this my will, In trust for the Intent and purposes in this my Will Contained. In Witness Whereof, I the said Michal Wilson have to this my last Will and Testament Set my hand and seal the Day and year above
