In the Name of God Amen. I Andrew Mote of Abbeville County in the State of S^c Carolina; Being Very Sick and Wake of Body but of perfect mind and memory. Thanks be to God for it, and considering the Uncertainty of life and the frailty of Human nature. first I recommend my Soul to God who gave it. and my body to the Earth, from whence it was taken, (to be burard in a decent and Christian like manner, at the discretion of my Executors herein after mentioned;) believing assuredly that the same shall be Raised again at the Resurrection--- first I Order and appoint that all my lawful debts be paid. Secondly I Give and beq^{ueath} to John Miller Jun^r son of Andrew Miller (deceas^d) one Shilling Sterling Money. Thirdly I give and bequeath Unto my Dear and well beloved wife Elizabeth Mote a ll my black Kettle Hogs, Houseld furniture, one loom and tacklings, and all the Bonds and Notes due to me for her Use and the same to be desposed of in the manner and form following Viz that my Executors is to sell all the articles above mentioned (Except them after Named) Giving one Years Credit and hereby I Impower them to Make a lawful¹ Right to the same, and The money arising from them With the bonds and Notes, to be laid out from time to time by my Ex^{rs} for the Use of my Said Wife Elizabeth Mote as she may stand in Need of the same; and she is to have for her^r Own Use, one Cow and Calf and such of the House Hold furniture as is Necessary for her Use and iorder my wareing apparel to be desposed of as above, and for the same purpose and if there is any Money or goods Remaining after her Decease I give and Bequeath the same to Margret and Esther Miller (daughters of Andrew Millers (deceased) And the same to be Equally divided to Each and I Constitute and appoint Ezekiel Evans

John Lesly and Samuel Watt Executors of this my last Will and Testament-----
